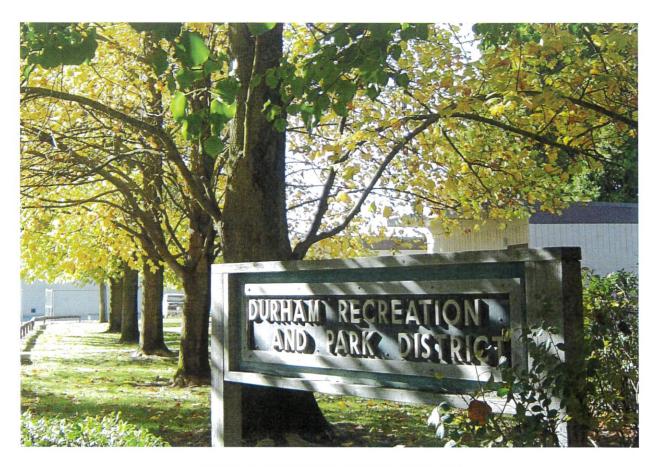

DISTRICT HISTORY

The Durham Recreation and Park District began with the Durham Community Park. This park has served as a social gathering place since the inception of the communities twenty-four acre park was specifically set aside when land allocations were established for the area in 1918. The district gained responsibility for the park in 1947. Through a property assessment of five cents, the District maintained and operated the park. The facility continues to be the largest District park area.

The Durham Recreation and Park District is an independent Special District under the supervising authority of its own elected Board of Directors, as authorized in the Public Resources Code. The Durham Recreation and Park District became one of five recreational special districts in Butte County in 1958. The District is a public service agency created by the people to provide adequate recreational areas and facilities to meet both present and future needs of the District.

Durham Mission Statement

Durham Recreation and Park District strives to provide quality and efficiently maintained recreation and park facilities, and comprehensive programs that promote community involvement, healthy lifestyles, cultural awareness, fiscal responsibility and environmental stewardship for a rural community.

District Boundaries

The District makes up 220 square miles of unincorporated Butte County, including the communities of Durham, Dayton, Nelson and a portion of Butte Valley. The population of the District is approximately six thousand persons. A community college is located within the District, near Pentz and Clark Roads. The boundaries of the District are contiguous with the Durham Unified School District.

PARKS AND FACILITIES

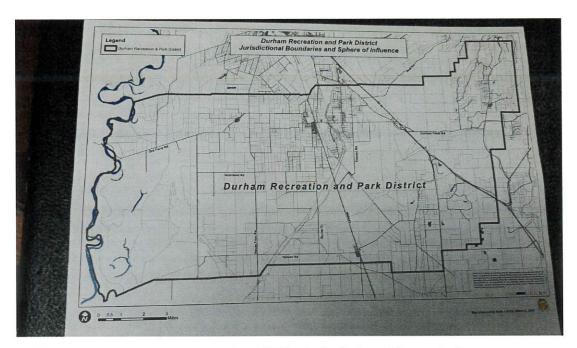
Currently, five park areas are maintained by the District. These areas include Durham Community Park, Ravekes Park, Louis Edwards Park, (Dwight Brinson Swim Center), Nelson Park and Midway Park. Descriptions of these parks are as follows:

Durham Community Park: This is Durham's oldest park. It was established in 1918 and the District gained responsibility for it in 1947, and consists of twenty-four acres. It features large covered and uncovered group picnic areas, small two-table picnic sites, a children's play structure, two ball fields, a sand volleyball court, horse-shoe pits and horse arena. The park is located on the Durham-Dayton Highway.

Ravekes Park: This is a small, half acre park that was donated to the District in 1982 by John Ravekes. The park is located south of the Jim Brinson Activity Center and consists of a small play area, picnic tables, and a tennis court/pickleball court.

Louis Edwards Park: This is a 3.86 acre park site that is home to the District Administrative Office and The Dwight Brinson Swim Center.

Nelson Park: This small park is located seven miles south of Durham, in the unincorporated community of Nelson. It features a small picnic area and a swing set. **Midway Park:** The District completed the initial stages of development on the new park located on the Midway and adjacent to school property in 1998. The park is open for use by the public and is home to sports programs through the D.R.P.D. and the Durham Unified School District.

DISTRICT FACILITIES

Dwight Brinson Swim Center. In March of 1975, DRPD Board of Directors approved purchase of land from the Durham Unified School District for the purpose of building a community pool. The pool was built, at a cost to the District, of approximately \$310,000 and was officially opened to the public in June of 1976. Since that opening day 46 years ago. The Dwight Brinson Swim Center has been the home to a long list of District sponsored aquatics programs, as well as the Durham Dolphins and Durham High School Swim Teams.

Durham Veterans Memorial Hall: The Veterans Memorial Hall was built in 1957, and is host to the Durham American Legion Post No. 673 and the Durham American Legion Auxiliary for meetings and functions. The District assumed operations of the Hall in 1992. The District currently maintains and uses the Hall for District sponsored special events, programs, and meetings. The Memorial Hall consists of a kitchen, large meeting room, Legion meeting room, main floor and stage area, and is available for use by the public.

Jim Brinson Activity Center: In the Spring of 2017, the District began construction of a new 7400 sq. foot multi-purpose activity center located at the south end of the 4.8 acre parcel, adjacent to Ravekes Park. The building was opened to the public in the fall of 2017. The new facility provides space for the District sponsored after school program and indoor recreational programs including basketball, volleyball and pickleball. The facility is available for use by the public for: team practices, drop-in play, birthday parties, meetings/trainings, dances, community events and more.
